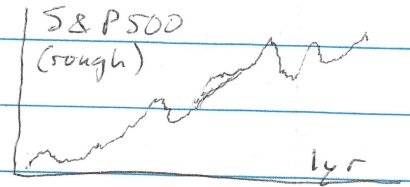
Sterling Daily (10/2/24): "My Vision for S.O.L.I.D." Goes Over Like a Lead Balloon
