- - - This story is a follow-up to a story about ^{my cellie,} Joseph being hit by a van going 45 mph when he was 7 y.o. dying, and coming back to life through his mom's praying in the name of Jesus; told he would never walk again, yet now he's healthy as can be, nearly. He's got scars that are consistent with that story. He twisted his ankle getting off the top bunk yesterday. He did ~~five~~ ^{three} up-side-down, or vertical push ups doing a hand stand against the wall.

This story ~~occur~~ begins a couple of years after the Van incident. His mom met a man named Robert Jones, who they call "Cosmo", while at a casino. They became boyfriend/girlfriends. They were watching "Touched by an Angel" about a kid who was hit by a car. She started crying. Cosmo asked her what was wrong. She replied that it reminded her of something that happened to her son, a couple of years ago. *poor.*

She told him the story, and as she was doing so, he said, "No way! That was me who came out of the nearby shop, came up to him, pushed his (protruding) brains back into his skull, and wrapped his head with a ~~towel~~ sweater."

Now, then, about 15 years later, Cosmo and Joseph's Aunt Rosie are together in a homeless encampment in ^{Oraville} ~~Orville~~, CA. Joseph's tent is not far away. The encampment is close to the Feather river - about 100 yards from Cosmo and Rosie's tent.

Cosmo ~~is~~ has a stroke, and Rosie wants Joseph to call 911. But Joseph, following the Spirit, said, "Let me try something first." He picked Cosmo up and carried him into

As he was raising him up out of the water, he commanded his spirit to come back into his body. [He died. (2/13/25)]

the river. ["Feather" River - sign of the Dove] He ~~set~~ immerses Cosmo below the water, praying in the Spirit, in the name of Jesus, baptizing him in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Ghost; # He came alive out of the water, looked at Joseph, and said, "You saved my life. I was dying. Had I not ~~saved~~ (helped) save your life (all those years ago) by wrapping that ~~towel~~ ^{sweater} around your ^{head}, you would not be here to save my life."

After telling this story, Joseph told me, "I'm amazed at what I can do with God. Nothing is impossible."
