That doesn't surpass how many people Mao Tse-tung killed (^{44-72M}~~100m~~) in the Color Revolution bringing Communism to China, starting 80 years ago. # → → → → → → → → → → # - seven years after the Yellow River Flood.

Synchronistically, this morning, I then (Sam) turned to ~~CNN~~ NTD's "PrimeTime-Unscripted", re-airing, where the first topic was the Rare Earth impediment by China this week, disrupting global supply chains of electronics, ranging from EVs to missile systems, creating near panic among the developed nations, esp. U.S. and Eu, who don't have domestic development capabilities presently - something that takes a decade to develop to scale.

Bessent roared, "If China wants to be an unreliable partner, the world will have to decouple." If only that were easy.

It's the "most humbling thing I've ever seen", referring to how the cost and quality (of manufacturing plant robots) is far superior to anything in the West. They describe vast, dark (robots don't need light) factories, no workers, cranking out cell phones. Last year, China added 295k robots, while the U.S. added 34k.

Perhaps they are so confident of their edge that they think it's now time to shut off the West's ability to manufacture, by removing a key they monopolize - the mining and refining/developing of crucial rare earth minerals.

Such a step is a final preliminary step to all-out war. The all-time high of gold and silver indicates a zeitgeist, collective worry about us being in precarious times. The rare-earth supply chain disruption is a main driver.

The most important remedy, as ^apeople, is to repent sufficiently to avert the destruction that breathes down our collective neck. Turning back to God and goodness will meet the level of divine intervention needed to turn away this destruction that ~~a~~ surely awaits us otherwise. A book could be written about how rare earth supply disruption could lead to massive calamity.
