7-y.o. Joseph Westbrook was Hit by Van Going 45 MPH;
Brought Back From Death; Fully Recovered

(This is one of five stories my celly, Joseph told me about his involvement in ~~the~~ people being brought back from the dead^{by Jesus' power.} I plan to do a story on each one. Two of the stories, including this one, are of his return from death.

This story occurred when he was seven years old. He was standing on a curve with his friend Thomas to his left. He was scanning traffic to the right, and ~~Thomas~~^{he thought} Thomas was scanning traffic to the left. Thomas was 13. This was on ^{March 3,} ~~an~~ 997.† He asked Thomas if it was clear, and assumed the answer to be 'yes'. He proceed into the road way, then "whack" was hit by a van going 45 miles per hour. Thomas ran to go get Joseph's mom.

Thomas later told EMS that Joseph was projected about 15 feet into the air (high) and went a distance of about 30 feet before hitting the pavement. EMS said there was a trail of blood and flesh 42 feet long.

It took about 10 minutes for EMS to arrive, who put a neck brace on him and loaded him on a gurney into ~~the~~ an ambulance. He was unconscious, not dead.

But almost immediately, a guy named Robert Jones, who goes by "Cosmo" was at a nearby shop and witnessed the accident, ^{and} ran to provide aid. Seeing Joseph's brain protruding from his skull, he tucked that back in and wrapped his head with his sweater. (Two years later, Cosmo met Joseph's mom at a casino and they started dating. When they were watching "Touched by an Angel", showing a story of a child being hit by a car, she started to cry. Cosmo asked ~~why~~ why, and she said a similar thing happened to her son.

It was reported the next day in the Sacramento Bee and Mercury Reporter - front page in at least one of them. This date is why ³³ is his fav. number.

As she retold the story, they put two and two together. 15 years later, Joseph saved Cosmo's life, bringing him back from a stroke. See my 2/1 blog article:

Joseph said he had a broken right femur at the hip, both shin bones were fractured, both arms were broken above the elbow, 12 ribs were broken, with multiple punctures of his ~~lungs~~ left lung. The left side of his face was impacted. He still bears a scar at his left eye brow, nearly the size of his eyebrow, which is indented about 3-5 mm.

As soon as he arrived at the Oraville Hospital (ACK), they put him on a life flight to Enloe Hospital. As soon as he arrived there, his left lung collapsed. A tube was inserted through his chest to drain the fluids, and blood. He showed me that scar below and behind his left nipple. It's about 12 mm in diameter.

Once he was breathing again, he was life flighted to U.C. Davis. On the way, they stopped to pick up a 9 y.o. girl who was hit by a Chevy S-10 truck. She didn't survive.

His mom later told him he looked like hamburger.

He spent three weeks on life support in an induced coma. The doctors told his mom he'd be in an induced coma for the rest of his life, be a paraplegic, never walk.

While he was on the other side he had two experiences he told me about. In one, he spoke to his late uncle Steve, who told him it wasn't his time to go. God had a divine plan for him. He needed to go back to earth.

Prior to that, Joseph said he went to the "12th Heaven" (many levels above what usually is described) while there, he felt a oneness with God. He could create an earth with a thought (if needed). He came back in what he described as "God speed."

Now he was at his body, hovering over it. It was an awful sight: Body cast, tubes going in & out,

wires, machines. ~~It was a pathetic sight.~~ He thought, "I don't want to go into that." Then "Jesus told me telepathically to trust him ^{and} lay back into ~~his~~ ^{my} body." That was his first interaction with Jesus directly in that experience.

His mom had also been praying over his body in the name of Jesus.

Once his spirit was back in his body, he woke up. Felt no pain. Was numb from the head down. [A function of the drugs to do the induced coma?] He said, He turned to his mom, awake, and said, "Momma, Jesus said everything's going to be okay." She cried (with gratitude, relief, and joy.) "She had faith I would be okay," Joseph told me.

Now that he was awake, after 3 weeks in a coma, they put him in a wheel chair, with his body cast, for 9 weeks. It was during this time that he met his dad for the first time, in a court setting. "Hello. Do you know who I am?" (No). "I'm your dad." Joseph had gauze and wraps covering the left side of his face.

After ^{that} 9 weeks, he was cut out of his body cast at U.C. Davis with "a little chain" saw. He didn't do physical therapy that he recalls. "Just healed." (gradually)

He was still in the wheel chair for about a month, but couldn't walk for about a month. At first, he could only walk stiffly; couldn't bend his knees. In another year, he learned how to run. That was in 2nd grade. After two years, he was the fastest runner in the school until the 8th grade, where one guy was able to run faster.

By nine years old, he was fully healed - by God.

About two years after the accident, he saw Thomas again. They had lost contact. He said, "I can't tell anyone else what I saw that day. When you were flying through the air, about half way [metaphysical gift:], it's like lightning struck you, and a (spherical) force field went around you. Then, before the van ran you over, I saw a

being with what appeared to be wings hover over you to protect you, like a bridge."

Postscript

Joseph didn't see his dad again until he was 17, when he lived with him for about a year. He said his dad "wasn't nurturing, was ^{uncaring} uncaring, but made sure I had necessities. He was doing drugs." They were living in an RV trailer.

When he was 18, he moved back with his mom.

Then, about four years ago, he and his dad were homeless together for about a year, in Oroville (still), CA.

His dad died of congestive heart failure three years ago. Joseph was 33 - a significant number for him.

More recently, Joseph has had three or four vivid dreams about his dad, in which they were having fun together. I told him my impression that his dad was allowed by God to give Joseph these dreams to show him how he wish his life could have been, had he not been enslaved to the drugs.

Joseph has been acknowledging many messages from God for him to stop his drug use, but he is still procrastinating that repentance. I'm seeing progress. At first he saw his drug use as a good thing (he came here Wed. night, 1/28). Now he's in denial about the depth of his addiction. He's being very reckless with his use, almost begging to get caught (his subconscious protector). He was caught this morning by a cop on one of them.
