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Trump Page: Ezk. 7:19 Gold & Silver Won't Deliver Us If no Repentance

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In conservative media, a common advertiser is some kind of gold procurement service, allegedly because historically, no matter what happens, e.g. fiat currency collapsing, gold maintains its value. However, Ezk. 7:19 prophesies of something very different:

"19 They shall cast their silver in the streets, and their gold shall be ~~reser~~removed: their silver and their gold shall not be able to deliver them in the day of the wrath of the Lord; they shall not satisfy their souls, neither fill their bowels: because it is the stumbling block of their iniquity."

Wickedness is the primary problem. We get the government we deserve. The only way to avert what's in store is for enough people to repent.

Here's the sobering point that brings this into focus and extreme relevance. That verse appears on page 1034 of the LDS Bible (KJV) © 1979, 2013. The ASCII sum of the string "Pres. Trump" = 1034. This whole page, spanning Ezk. 7:25-20 — actually, the whole chapter depicts what could very well happen today if we don't repent.

The second line of text on the page reads, "An end, the end is come upon the four corners of the land."

Half way through the page depicts e.g. tariffs gone awry:

"12 The time cometh, the day draweth near: let

not the buyer rejoice, nor the seller mourn: For wrath is upon all the multitude thereof.

13 For the seller shall not return to that which is sold, although they were yet alive: for the vision is touching the whole multitude thereof, which shall not return...

14 They have blown the trumpet, even to make all ready; but none goeth to the battle: for my wrath is upon all the multitude thereof.

15 The sword is without, and the pestilence and the famine within...
