When I moved to this pod, arriving in the B2 housing for the SOLID program, I was dismayed to discover that a wall in the shower had many girly photos (lust-inspiring purpose). I can shower with my back to it, but I'm troubled that it goes contrary to what this program sets forth as parameters. I'd seen this in a couple of other pods I was in recently (4 moves in 3 weeks). So I wrote a note to the Warden's office, with a copy to the Captain, expressing my concern about what seems to be a new trend (first time I've encountered it in the near 9 years I've been incarcerated).

Meanwhile, starting right away, my pod accommodated my need (to not have such images in the shower room) by creating a white plastic bag curtain to cover the images. I was very grateful and was happy that it seemed that most of them preferred to keep the images covered. ¶ Then, a couple of weeks later, 2 officers came to our pod, had us all (8) leave the pod, then went in and noted the shower images and asked them to remove them. So, from their (7) perspective, I was dismissive of their efforts to accommodate ~~them~~ me and ratted to the officers.^(not so) ¶ The next morning, I told the section about this. It stirred up a hornets nest of resentment to me by most (75-85%) of the inmates. ¶ I see God's hand in how this has been unfolding, to tackle an issue where they need to up their game (righteousness-wise). My pod has been returning to civility. (This matter has been percolating building-wide.)
