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D&C 93:1 & 1Ne.11:1 Quest - Last Day this Episode

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When I launched the present quest in earnest on 11/11, I somewhat randomly selected a window spanning 1111-1121. When I looked at those pages in the Bible and saw that the book of Daniel concludes near the end of p. 1121, I saw more significance in that span. You can see in my previous article, "D&C 93:1 & 1Ne.11:1 Experience Today?" (11/20) that I had high expectations that this ^{theophany} would materialize yesterday, and that I would be okay if it didn't, seeing this as a sign that society has been given more time because of all the good people stepping up against evil.

This morning, I reviewed what I had found on 1121 (today's date) with the question of whether I should halt this quest for now and stop my Fast. ^{my notes about} The p. 1121 of the last page of Daniel is what spurred me to continue through the end of today. Also, I noticed that the page heading on p. 759 (facing 758 = "Nov. 20, 2023", corresponding with 11/21) of Str.'07 is "More-Morning." I saw that as possibly pointing to this theophany occurring this morning (it didn't).

In getting myself into an aligned frame of mind, I ^{was} reading ^{ing} Eth. 3-4. In seeing 3:26 again, I realized it would have made an excellent cross-

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reference/citation for the word "withhold" on p. 758 wot. I ended up memorizing it, as a good way to keep my focus on the guest (took about an hour).

"26 For he [the Lord] ~~ad~~ had said unto him [the brother of Jared] in times before, that if he would believe in him that he could show unto him all things — it should be shown unto him [redundant for emphasis]; therefore the Lord could not withhold anything from him, for he knew that the Lord could show him all things." [I know this even more surely, and with all the advancement of human knowledge, I have an even more keen sense of "all things" parameters.]

<5:24> (watching Young Sheldon, which I love. The script writer is excellent/brilliant (old soul); the ^{cast} actors are perfect for (except the femmy preacher) their roles. ^ Big Bang Theory (about young adult Sheldon) is awful. Ch. Way too fixated on sex; characters are cheesy, superficial, terrible actors. I can't see why it's popular.)

I'm a bit burned out on this theophany quest, having put so much into it, only for nothing to materialize (yet, at this juncture. I'm confident it will eventually). While these let-downs are hard to take, realizing this is just another dry run at the metaphorical flight simulator, I've noticed that the longer this r.c. quest goes on, the more majestic/amazing the scenario/paradigm becomes. It will be worth the patience/wait.

I just reread p. 1121 of the Bible, spanning Dan. 12:16-13. Most things depicted on that page will be

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averted by our evoking the r.c. That's actually depicted at the opening of the page with the wording, "and at that time thy people shall be delivered" thanks to "Michael... the great prince which standeth up for... the people."
